Reference: TP/ED/20/0339 – COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

During our engagement with the Local Community Council, they raised several concerns regarding traffic speed on Main Street/A891 Lennoxton, the main access road to our proposed development.

In consultation with the Local Community Council, they have investigated the benefits any development could bring to the area. The main focus was on pedestrian safety and safe routes.

There were 642 individuals involved in the consultation process, all of whom shared opinions on speed calming options – Speed Bumps (126), Average Speed Cameras (185) and Pedestrian Crossings (331).

There was a clear desire for additional pedestrian crossings in the area. On this basis we have commissioned our traffic engineer to advise on suitable locations within the area, that will contribute to pedestrian safety.

The A891/Main Street runs for approximately 2 km through Lennoxton, within this 2km stretch there are 2 pedestrian crossings.

Our intention is to implement the pedestrian crossing at an agreed location and legal agreement with the Council.

We would welcome feedback from you on this proposal.
